

### 7TH GRADE IMMUNIZATION ASSESSMENT WORKSHEET

*Tool for determining the reporting status of 7th grade students. Column A is a tally of children up-to-date on all required vaccines, Column B is a tally of children with a valid medical exemption, Column C is a tally of children with a valid religious exemption, Column D is a tally of children "in-process" for their immunizations, Column E is a tally of children non-compliant for immunization and Column F is a tally of children with no documentation of immunizations (this is rare).*

*Directions:* For each student, enter a "1" in the column (A-F) that is appropriate for the student. Then, insert a "1" under each vaccine for which the child is up-to-date. The total at the bottom of the spreadsheet will give you the numbers to respond to the survey questions.

\*"in process" of being age appropriately immunized means a child has received all required immunizations he or she is eligible to receive according to the public health division school/daycare entry immunization requirements, but has not completed one or more vaccine series because a sufficient time interval has not elapsed for the subsequent dose or doses of vaccine to be administered according to the recommended intervals between doses published by the ACIP.
