

OMI Reportable Deaths

If the terms below are on a death certificate, the case should be reported to OMI.

Poisoning
Intoxication / toxicity
Hip fractures
Pelvic fractures
Compression fractures
Pulmonary embolism
Subdural, subarachnoid or epidural hematomas / hemorrhages
Any kind of falls
Head injuries
Seizures
Asphyxia
Anoxic brain injuries
Paraplegia / quadriplegia
IV drug use
Overdose
Hypoxia

Contact our office immediately BEFORE filing the death certificate. The following information would be helpful to our office:

- Doctor's name and phone number
- Family's name and phone number

The investigator will need to investigate the circumstances of the death. OMI will most likely pick up the case and reissue the death certificate. Sometimes after speaking with the primary care physician the death is determined not to fall under OMI jurisdiction. In these cases the primary care physician will need to sign a new death certificate.
