COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Data

NMDOH Requests Providers Ensure COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Data Collection and Entry

June 14, 2021

Background

New Mexico is approaching our statewide goal of 60% of the population > 16 years of age fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

Telephone surveys conducted by the Department of Health suggest that a significant number of individuals who have completed the COVID-19 vaccine series do not have their second dose accurately documented in the State Immunization Information System (NM-SIIS).

The state is committed to ensuring the most accurate data possible and is asking for assistance from the provider community.

Recommendations for Clinicians

- Please perform a thorough review of vaccine data entry processes in each of your offices, hospitals, and systems.
 - Ensure that staff are entering records into the electronic health record (EHR) or NM-SIIS.
 - Ensure that any data links between your EHR and NM-SIIS are functioning correctly and there are no data transmission failures.
 - Identify any records waiting for entry.
- The Governor is requesting that all providers ensure complete and up to date vaccine administrative data by close of business Tuesday, June 15th.
