Reading Your Unit Report

Patients in the program can purchase up to 425 patient units of cannabis and/or cannabis products over a rolling three- month period (or 90 days). Patients can purchase a variety of products including dried flower, as well as alternative products such as edibles, tinctures, and topicals.

What is a "Patient Unit"?



For dried flower, *1 patient unit equals 1 gram*. 425 units is approximately 15 ounces of dried flower product.



For any other product such as edibles, tinctures, oils, topicals, etc. *1 patient unit is equal to 200 milligrams* (or 0.2 grams) of THC contained in the product.

EXAMPLE	Total THC	Calculation (product mgs/200)	Patient Units	Calculation (425/patient units)	How Much You Can Buy?	Total Units
Chocolate Bar	200 mg	200/200=	1 unit	425/1=	425 bars	425 units
Capsules	40 mg	40/200=	.2 units	425/.2=	2125 caps	425 units
Tincture/ Oil	400 mg	400/200=	2 units	425/2=	212 oil containers	425 units
Wax	1000 mg	1000/200=	5 units	425/5=	85 wax containers	425 units

The total number of patient units you can purchase is 425 in a 90 day period. It can include different items. In the example above, within a 90-day period, you might buy 80 grams/units of dried flower, 48 tinctures (2 units/tincture), 50 chocolate bars (1 unit/bar), and still have 199 patient units left.

All items from an approved dispensary should be labeled with the total amount of THC and number of patient units. If something you want to buy is not labeled, **ask a store employee**.

What is a "Rolling Three-Month Period"?

Your patient units are tracked every time you purchase products from a dispensary. Patient units that you purchase today will fall off your total patient unit count after 90 days (based on the rolling three-month period).

At at any point you can ask an employee at the dispensary how many patient units you have left before you purchase anything.

If you think there is an error on your unit report, please send a letter or an email to our office*. Include the date and time of the purchase listed and what you think is wrong. We will check the purchase and notify you of what we find.

* Units may be uploaded from dispensaries to the State system after business hours.
