- ❖ Developed the 2012-2013 ICC Legislative Action Plan.
- ❖ Voted to accept the draft Service Definitions and Standards if the language on maximum caseloads for Family Service Coordinators is removed or revised.
- ❖ Voted to write a letter stating why EPSDT Special Rehabilitation Services provided by the Family Infant Toddler Program should be excluded from Centennial Care and continue as a fee for service under the Medicaid State Plan.
- ❖ Discussed work being accomplished by the ICC's Finance, Personnel Development & Support, and Quality Committees.
- ❖ Discussed how FIT programs might utilize *New Mexico Early Learning Guidelines: Birth through Kindergarten* and alignment of services for children birth through five years.
