



## INTERAGENCY COORDINATING COUNCIL (ICC)

### January 2015 Meeting Highlights

- ❖ Learned about the early intervention services provided by the NM School for the Deaf Early Intervention and Involvement Division.
- ❖ Voted to recommend Shandra Clow to the Governor for appointment as an ICC Parent Representative.
- ❖ Voted to support a legislative request of \$1.5 million dollars to fund the 2003 recommended rates from the Cost Study and an appropriation request of \$6.7 million dollars to cover the increased cost of providing FIT services including cost of living allowances (COLAs).
- ❖ Voted to endorse the State Performance Plan (SPP)/Annual Performance (APR) Report, have the ICC Co-Chairs sign the report, and have the FIT Program submit the report to OSEP and the Governor.
- ❖ Learned about the benefits of FIT early intervention services from the ICC Parent Panel.
- ❖ Voted to approve ICC Committee reports.
- ❖ Voted to accept the Lead Agency Report with the assurance that the FIT Program would check on the requested figures.
- ❖ Voted to endorse the following changes to FIT eligibility: children born under 28 weeks are eligible under established condition and children born under 28 weeks or up to 34 weeks are eligible under biological/medical risk.
